Dear Mr Kendal:

The report summarizes my onsite evaluation of your Clean Water Act and Resource Conservation and Recovery Act laboratory for certification renewal. Because of the mostly favorable findings from my onsite evaluation, your laboratory's certification is being provisionally approved for three years provided your laboratory continues to meet the main requirements for maintaining certification. Once I have received your audit response and deem it to be acceptable, you will be fully certified. The main requirements for maintaining the recognition of certification are (1) that your laboratory continue to report acceptable results, at least annually, for each certified parameter on proficiency test studies; (2) that your laboratory continue to use EPA approved methods for analysis of each certified parameter ; and (3) that I be notified, in writing, within thirty days of any changes in laboratory staff, equipment, or laboratory location that might impair analytical capability.
